Bluevale cemetery is located on concession 1, lot 29, (plan 166, pk lots 106-110) in Turnberry township, Huron County.

On December 17, 1860, the Crown gave a patent to ALEXANDER DUNCAN for the 100 acres of lot 29 and he had the land surveyed for a village. This became known as "DUNCAN'S SURVEY". ALEXANDER DUNCAN later gave the village of Bluevale over three acres of this land- pk lots 106 to 109.

Part of lot 110 (one-fifth of an acre) was purchased by the Bluevale Cemetery Committee from ROBERT L. SIBBALD on Nov.15,1893 for \$25, which made the cemetery almost four acres. The trustees who signed the deed were JOHN MILLER, JAMES ELLIOTT, GEORGE AITCHIESON, and WILLIAM JAMES JOHNSTON. These men formed the Bluevale Cemetery Association.

For many years, when a death occurred, the family was responsible for digging the grave. Most often a neighbour would take over the task for the family. Of late, STU HALLOWAY, of Wingham, had dug the graves, through the Wingham undertaker.

There has never been perpetual care arrangement available. For many years the cemetery had little care given to it. Some took care of their own families graves and those of friends. Saplings, shrubs, and weeds grew until it was overgrown.

Eventually people began to realize that something should be done. About 1950 a clean-up bee was held. MAC and FLEM BLACK, with five men who worked for them, hired a bulldozer and hauled the unsightly growth to the dump, levelled and seeded the ground. Since then a number of different people have kept the grass cut-JOE THOMPSON, JACK THOMPSON, HARRY ELLIOTT, LYLE CAMPBELL and ELAINE CAMPBELL.

Other bees have been held to set stones erect again and firm up monument foundations, to put loads of soil in the low areas of the cemetery. Some donated, not only their time, but loads of the soil. It has been a very "community" affair.

The plots have been sold for many years, there being only one left. The cemetery itself is hemmed in by the river, the highway, and the buildings, it cannot expand further. One area near the river had to be closed because the ground was too low. Very often, before a funeral, water had to be bailed from the dug grave. The "bailer" would stop only at the approach of the hearse and quickly hide in the bushes.

Bluevale Cemetery seems to have attracted more people from Morris Township than from Turnberry Township. In a few years it (cemetery) will be closed. Then it will be the kindness of those who are left to show the way in which it is kept. HAROLD JOHNSTON and MAC BLACK are the present Cemetery Board Members- and they will very likely be the last.

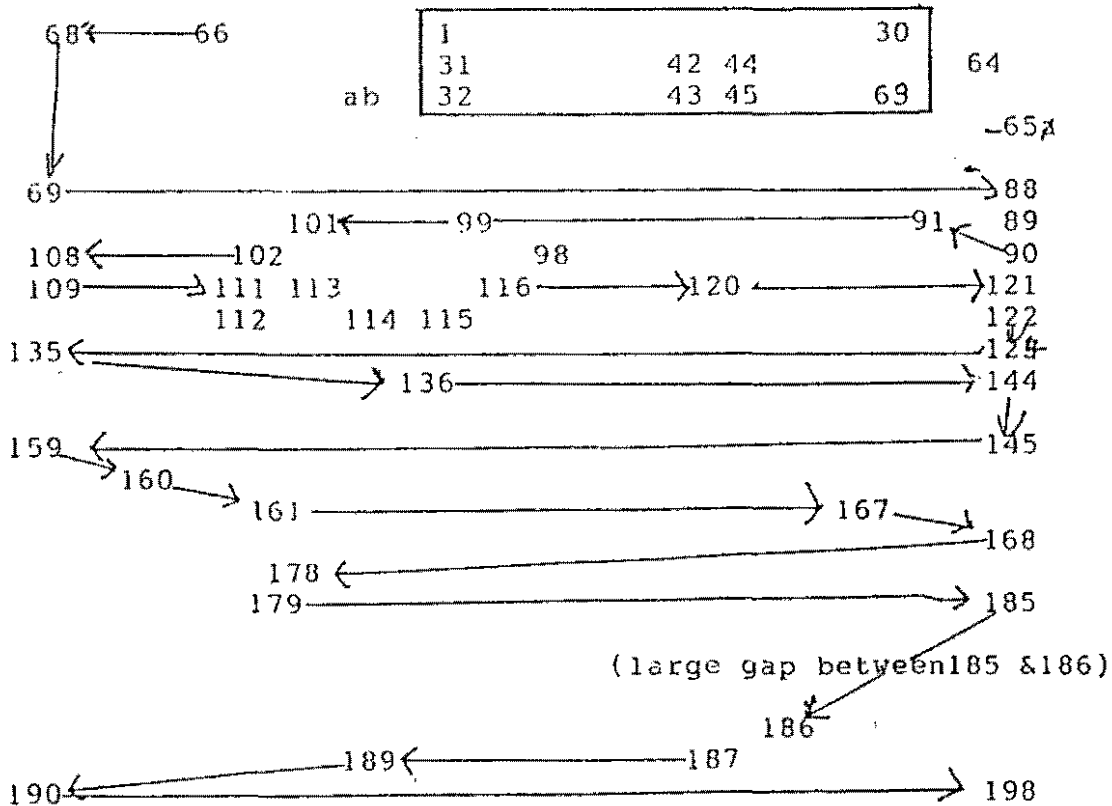
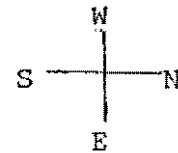

# Plan Bluevale Special Service

Free Press Northern Bureau  
BLUEVALE, June 13 — Knox Presbyterian Church, Bluevale, Sunday will commemorate the 100th anniversary of the calling of the first Presbyterian minister to Bluevale. Early in the year 1858 application was made to call a minister to the congregations of Bluevale, Morrisbank, Wrooketer and Ainleyville (now Brussels).

The Rev. W. C. Young was called and the first Communion observed in the home of R. Duncan with 13 persons.

For some time the church services were conducted in the schoolhouse, but in 1866 a frame church was erected to serve the congregation.

In 1907 a new brick church was built during the ministry of the Rev. W. J. West. This church now serves the United Church congregation at Bluevale. Following the vote on church union in 1925 the present edifice was erected and still serves the congregation.

To commemorate the occasion a plaque will be placed in the vestibule and dedicated Sunday at special services to be held morning and evening. Speaker will be the Rev. J. R. Greig, a former pastor. Music will be presented by the choir and a London quartet.

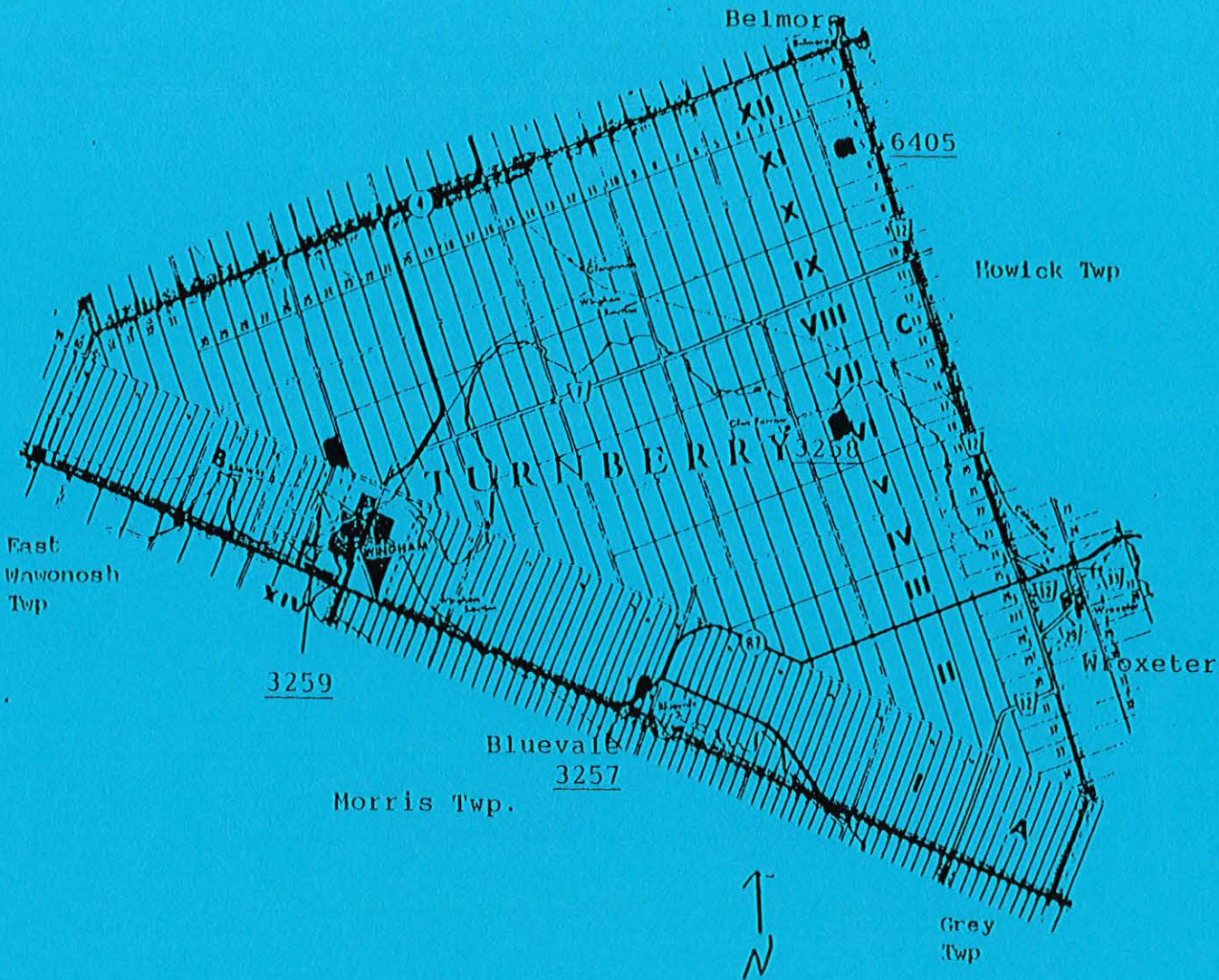
