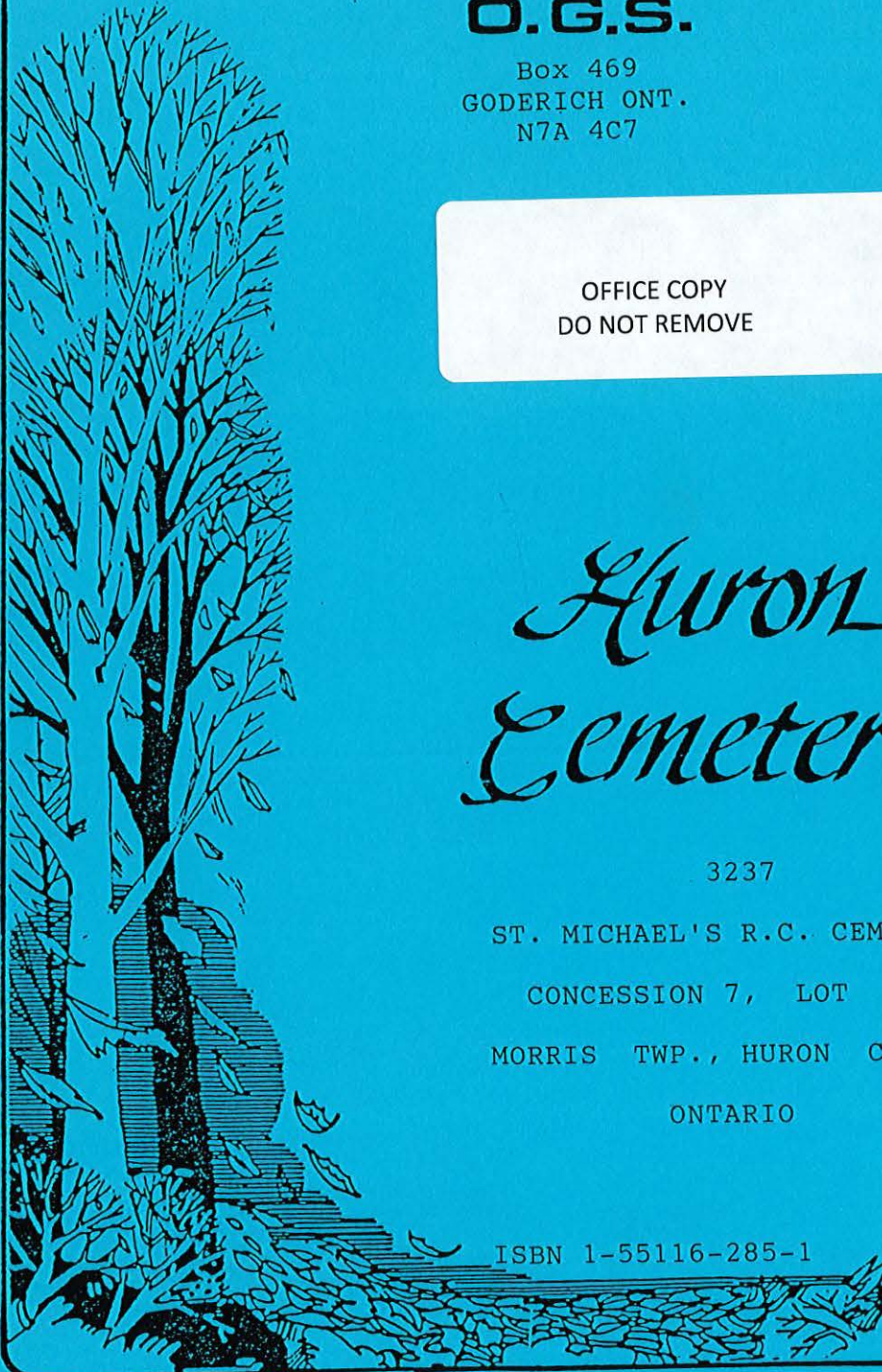

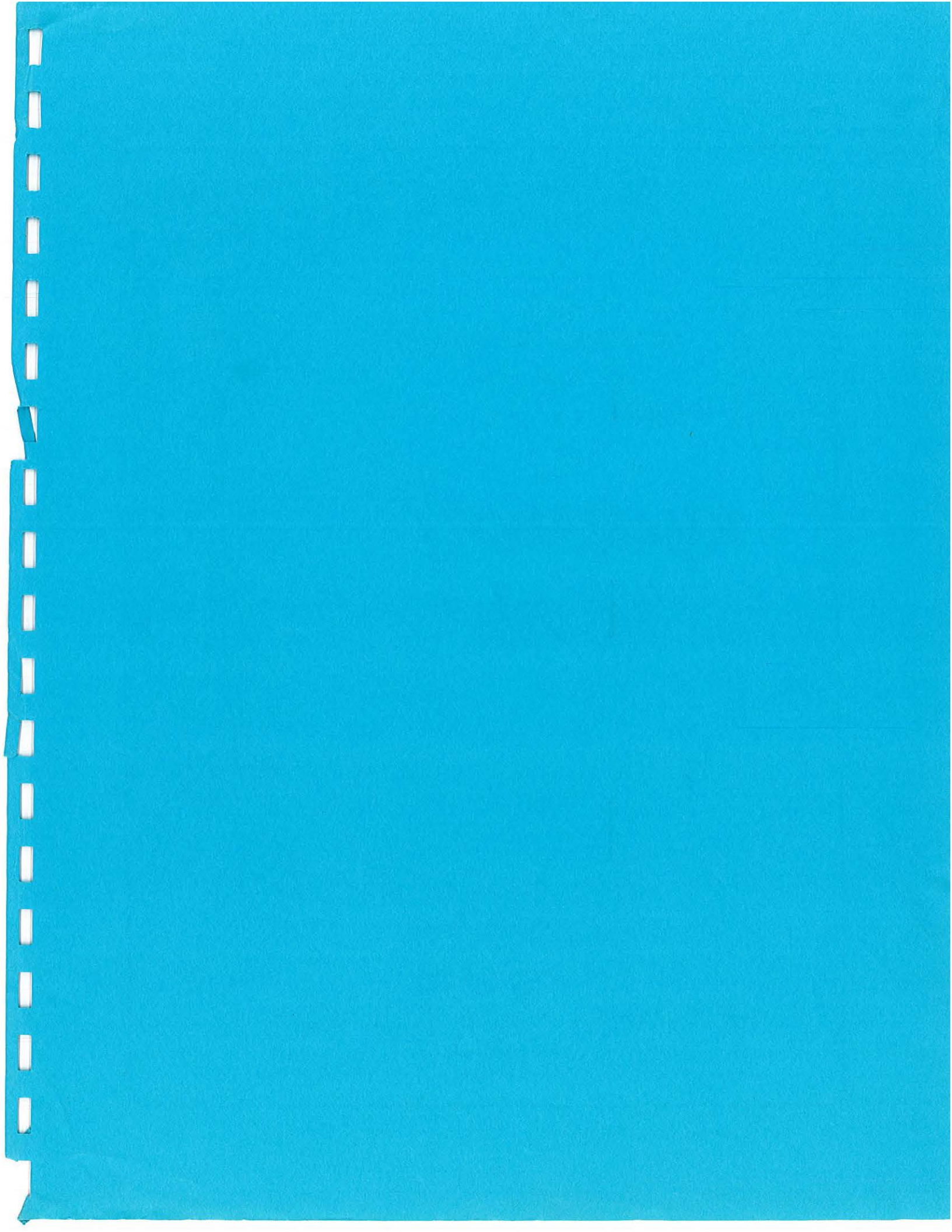

CONCESSION 7, LOT 12

John Kelly arrived in Bushfield in 1852 with his wife, six sons and two daughters. They had come from Tipperary Ireland.

It was not until 1869, July 6, that he received the patent from the Crown for the South half of Lot 12 Con.7, Township of Morris.

One of the first things he did was to set aside 1 acre of land to be used as a site for a log church and cemetery.

St. Michael's is a very beautiful cemetery. The church had adjoined it from 1852 to 1878. In 1878 the church was moved to Blyth but the cemetery remains.

The first mass was in 1852 by Father Wasserau of Ashfield. It was connected to Ashfield until 1873 when it became attached to St. Columban or Irishtown. Mass was held once a month.

Father Murphy who was the pastor at St. Columban was responsible for the removal of St. Michael's church to Blyth in 1878.

Next they were joined to St. Augustine but by 1901 in January Clinton and Blyth were joined. This congregation has given the R.C. Church to date, four priests and seven nuns.

On June 23 1876, John Kelly made a will which was registered Nov.17, 1882. In it, he willed "all to my son William except 1 acre in the S.W. corner of said lot, now occupied partly for a burying ground and partly for a church site, which I bequeath to the Roman Catholic Church so long as it be used for a church site and burying ground - but when not occupied for church or burying ground to be used by son William or his heirs." This John Kelly signed with his mark, an X.

In 1956 Rev. Graham sent a letter to his parishioners. It was 100 years since the first Catholic settlers arrived in Morris. Much time and money was spent in the years 1954 - 1956 to remodel the cemetery.

A beautiful statue of St. Michael was to be purchased for the cemetery. To pay for it there was to be two lists of donors. One was to remain at St. Michael's Church, Blyth. The other was to be placed in the base of the statue - there to remain until the next centenary.. One name could be placed for every five dollar donation.

It had been May 9, 1954 when the first meeting with the purpose of setting up a Cemetery Board was called by the Priest. Up to this time any care of the cemetery was done, free will, and often at the suggestion of the Priest.

Simon Hallahan was appointed Secretary and still remains active; James Phelan was Chairman; Leo Kelly and Father Graham were the other members of the new Board.

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At this time a single grave was \$10 ; \$15 for a lot of 2 graves ; \$25 for 4 graves. One hundred dollars was Perpetual Care fee and five dollars to open a grave. Removal of a body cost \$60.

There was to be no planting of trees, shrubs or plants without permission.

All cheques had to be signed by the chairman and secretary - treasurer. There was to be one board meeting each year.

To begin each family was asked for \$15 to help with a "bee."

Grading equipment was hired. The cemetery was levelled and seeded. New posts were installed and a new fence put up.

The Statue of St. Michael was not to cost more than \$525. Four white stone angels were included in this. Father Graham went to Montreal to purchase this beautiful white stone Statue of St. Michael with his foot on the dragon's head, as well as the four white angels.

There was to be a special collection for outstanding debts in 1956.

In 1960, Nov. 14 the Cemetery Inspectors came around. New motions which followed this visit were: two new members were added to the Board; a map or plan of the cemetery was to be prepared; price of each grave was raised to \$50. (this did not pass the Cemetery Inspector's approval).

In 1964 five members were appointed to see about painting the fence - buying the paint and organizing a "bee" to do the job. The lawn mower needed repairs also.

Money was to be invested at British Mortgage and Trust Co.

A tariff rate of \$35 per grave was approved as was the map or plan.

The first Sunday in September prayers were said for the Cemetery.

In May 1966 it was decided to send for a form to be used in the sale of plots. These forms had Perpetual Care as well as the deed of the plot. They were available from the Director of Cemeteries.

April 1967 the price of grave plus opening was discussed, \$65 was the amount. In June 1971 this was approved.

In 1969 the cemetery needed filling and levelling of many of the graves. A "bee" accomplished this task.

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More land was also a subject under fire in 1969. Since the Board had aquired some equipment a small building was required to house it. Large sheets of wood were needed to protect the sides of the grave from caving in. The building was to occupy the N.E. corner.

By 1981 the price of a grave was \$90, 35% going to Perpetual Care fund.

Father Pluta was to write Regional Inspector, H.C. Fletcher, about using the old cemetery as the Catholic Church would allow burial in ground 30 years or older.

Since 1982 problems have arisen about the height of the road in front. It seems it has been too high.

Tariffs in 1982 were \$40 for Perpetual Care and \$60 for the plot. It is \$25 for those outside the congregation.

A thank you to Morris Council members for their cooperation and help, was given in 1983. A small safe, costing about \$200, was bought to keep important records in, in case of fire.

Dec. 1984 Father Pluta explained that the Perpetual Care money that was invested at Victoria and Grey must be moved to the Catholic Episcopal Corporation.

Two new members were added to the Board in 1985.

These Board members have served faithfully over the years since the first Board in 1954. They not only gave of their time but have worked many hours to make their cemetery a very outstanding one in the area.

At the back of this cemetery stands a very beautiful white stone statue of St. Michael with his foot on the dragon's head.

Clustered around the base of the statue in 2 tiers are old stones of those pioneers who first occupied this cemetery.

At the entrance to the cemetery stand 4 white angels on the top of 4 white pillars. Two on each side of the gate, facing it as if on guard over loved ones, at rest inside. Two in the front corners bent over in prayer and humility.

A Short History Of ST. Michael's Cemetery 7th Line of Morris Twp.

St. Michael's cemetery has recently undergone thorough renovations, and is now one of the beauty spots of the Township pf Morris, which is a great credit to the parishioners of St. Michael's.

The cemetery site is also one of the oldest established in the district, dating back to the year 1852 when the land was donated by the late John Kelly, grandfather of Mr. Leo Kelly, who settled on the 7th concession in 1852.

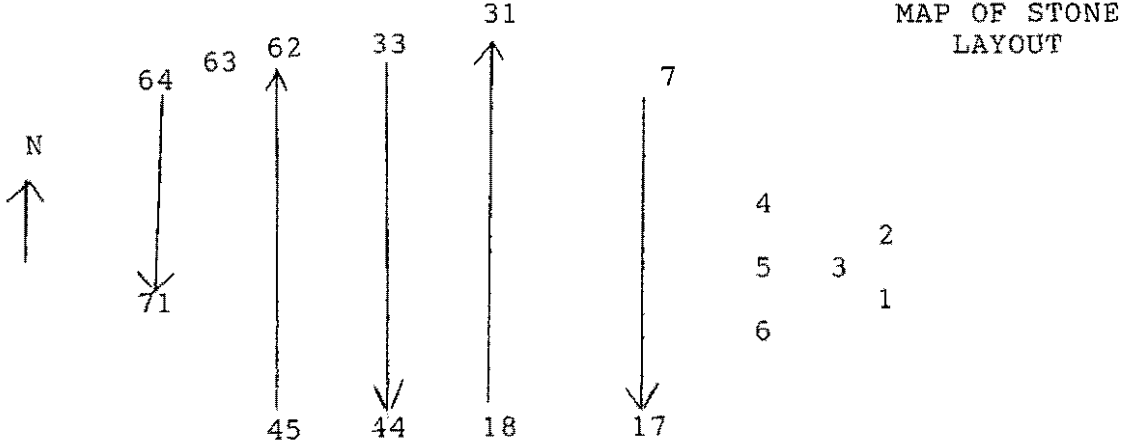
The base of the statue is adorned with old tombstones on which is inscribed the names of the pioneers of the township. The oldest burial on record is that of Sarah Bradley, aged 22 years and 4 months, who died on April 17th, 1854. The statue bears the following inscription:

"In Memory Of The Pioneers of St. Michael's Church, Morris - 1852 - 1878. St. Michael's Church also stood on this site until 1878 when it was moved to its present location at Blyth.

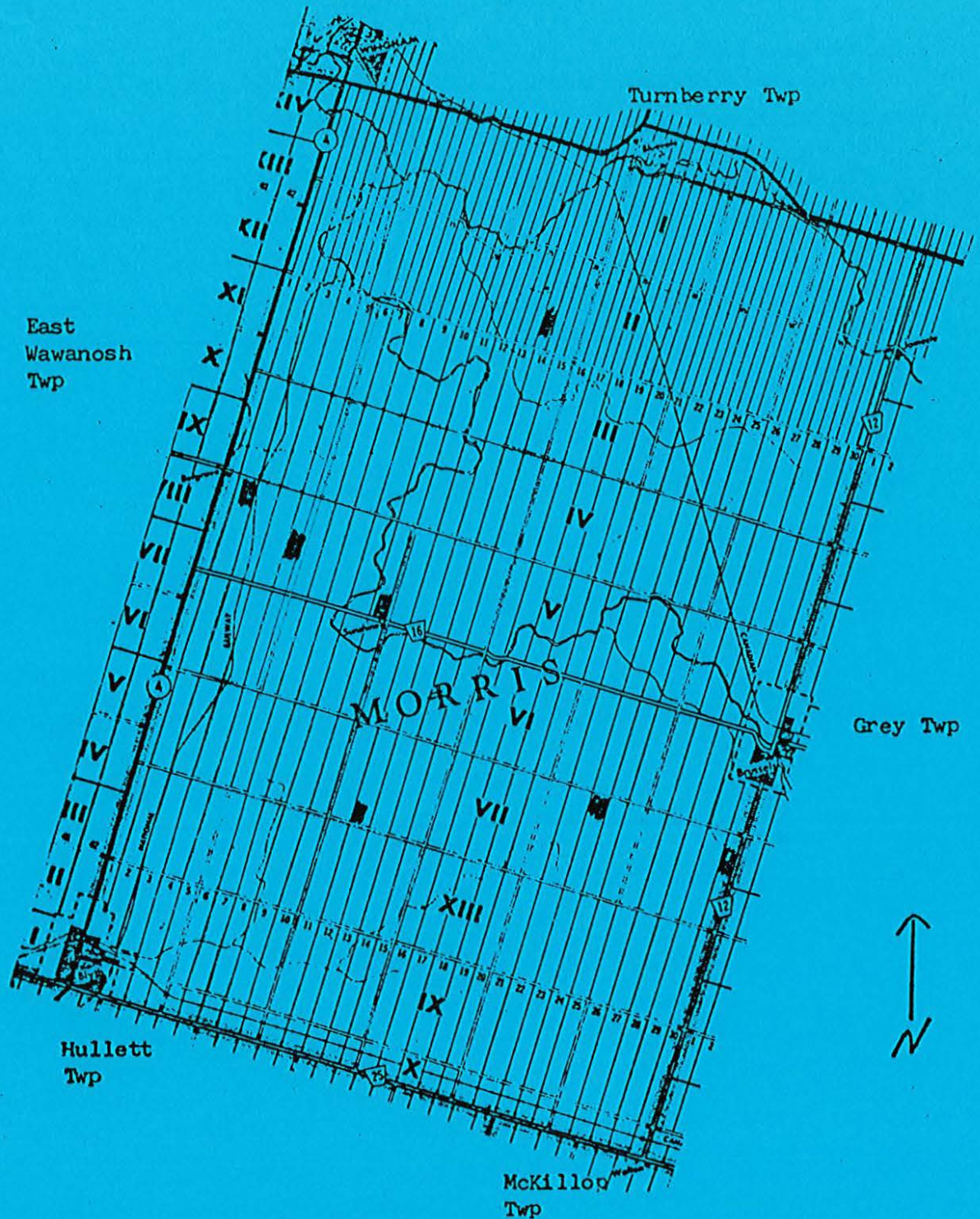
