7.1 CLERK

7.1.1 COVID-19 Update

A report was presented by CAO/Clerk Trevor Hallam in this regard for the information of Council.

Mayor Heffer informed Council that he participated in a meeting called by MPP Lisa Thompson on the weekend to share information on the changes to the regulations with all heads of Council in Huron-Bruce.

7.2 PLANNING

7.2.1 Planning Activities Q1 2021

A planning activity report for January through March 2021 was presented by Deputy Clerk Kim Johnston for the information of Council.

Councillor Freiburger commented that he appreciated seeing the list, and that he liked the idea of getting the quarterly update. Mayor Heffer agreed.

7.3 PUBLIC WORKS

7.3.1 2021 Surface Treatment Contract

A report was presented by Director of Public Works Mike Alcock in this regard.

Mr. Alcock noted that the tenders were very close, with a difference of only approximately .1% of the total bid.

Councillor Nelemans asked if Norjohn Contracting and Paving had completed the work on the rest of Salem Road. Mr. Alcock confirmed that Norjohn had been awarded the surfacing contracts in 2018, 2019 and 2020, and that the other respondent, Cornell Construction had the contract in 2017.
