INTERNET/TELEPHONE VOTING

Electors in the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry will be voting by internet and/or telephone, in the 2026 municipal election. There will be no paper ballot.

A Voter Information Letter will be mailed to you directly, in the month of October, providing you with a Personal Identification Number (PIN) which will allow you to vote 24 hours a day for 7 days between **October 13th – 26th**, from any telephone or any device connected to the internet.

If access to a telephone or internet connection is unavailable to you, a Voter Help Centre will be provided with telephone and internet access during the voting period at the Municipal office. Contact the Municipal office for dates and times of operation.

Proof of identity and residence is required in the following instances:

- when adding or deleting your name from the Voters' List
- when correcting your information on the Voters' List
- when re-issuing, activating or deactivating a PIN
- when swearing an oath
