



MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS-TURNBERRY PUBLIC NOTIFICATION FOR CONCRETE CULVERT ON McCALL LINE NORTH OF BLYTH ROAD

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

THE PROJECT:

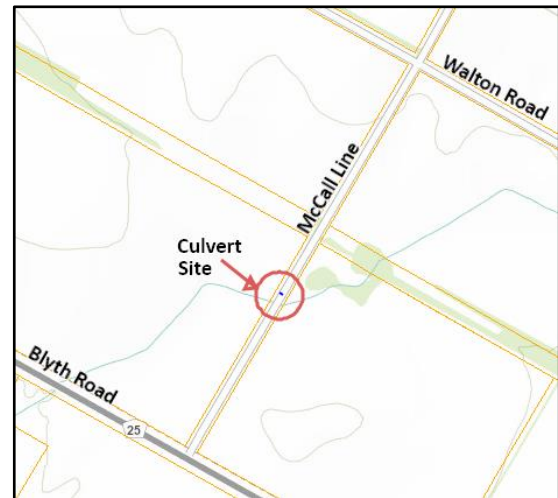
The Municipality of Morris-Turnberry has initiated a public notification and consultation process to consider options associated with the McCall Line Culvert (M020) which spans the Murray-Lamb Drain along McCall Line, approximately 250 m north of Blyth Road (as shown on the accompanying key plan). Recent inspections of the structure have identified some deterioration of structural components. The Municipality is considering all reasonable options in conjunction with the public notification and consultation process, including: 1) Replacement of the existing concrete culvert with a cast in place culvert, 2) Replacement of the existing culvert with a precast culvert, 3) Closure and removal of the existing culvert and bank stabilization of the Murray-Lamb Drain.

PROJECT TIMING:

The Municipality intends on having all of the design work completed in 2021 for the chosen option to be executed between July 15th and September 30th 2022.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING PROCESS:

The planning for this project is following the planning process established for Schedule 'A+' activities under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) document. Schedule 'A+' projects are pre-approved pending public notification. The purpose of the public notification is to inform the public of municipal infrastructure projects in their area. Comments from the public will be directed to the Council of the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry where they will be considered during the decision-making process.



PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:

Public input and comments are invited for incorporation into the planning and design of this project. The Municipality requests all comments be received by **November 27, 2020**, at the address listed below. Any comments collected in conjunction with the study will be maintained on file for use during the project and may be included in project documentation.

With the exception of personal information, all comments will be directed to Municipal Council and become part of the public record.
